



Electricity runs through, under and over our homes through wires. Each year hundreds of people are injured by **electricity** in and around their homes.

Here are some quick tips from the Electrician Bros. team to keep you and your family using **electricity safely and economically:**

1. Teach your children not to stick anything into electrical power points or electrical appliances such as your toaster.
 2. Teach you children about overhead power lines and that they should not climb trees , fly kites or remote control toys or throw balls near them.
 3. Keep electrical appliances away from water sources such as taps and sinks.
 4. Before you clean any electrical appliance, make sure it is switched off and unplugged from the power point.
 5. Electrical cords can overheat, so make sure you never run cords under furniture or carpets.
 6. Make it a habit to switch your appliances off from the power point and unplug them when you aren't using them.
 7. Do not overload power points with double adaptors and power boards.
 8. Never carry your electrical appliances by their cord.
 9. Make sure your television antenna is far enough from overhead power lines that it will not touch if blown over.
 10. Never work near a power line. If there is an electrical work that needs to be done contact us or your electricity provider.
